THE GENERAL PUBLIC IS HEREBY INFORMED THAT THE SIERRA LEONE ROADS AUTHORITY (SLRA) WILL EMBARK ON THE INSTALLATION OF CROSS DRAINS AT KOSSOH TOWN/MOKOR TOWN JUNCTION, ALONG THE REGENT – JUI ROAD.

AS A RESULT OF THIS INTERVENTION THE SECTION OF THE ROAD BETWEEN KOSSOH TOWN AND MOKOR TOWN JUNCTION WILL BE PARTIALLY CLOSED. DURING THIS INTERVENTION ONLY THE REQUIRED LANE WIDTH WILL BE RESTRICTED WHILST MAINTAINING ACCESS FOR ROAD USERS ON THE OTHER LANE. THIS SECTION OF THE ROAD WILL BE PARTIALLY CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC COMMENCING ON SATURDAY MAY 30TH, 2026 – SATURDAY JUNE 6TH 2026 AND WILL BE REOPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC ON SUNDAY JUNE 7TH, 2026.

MOTORISTS ARE KINDLY ADVISED TO USE ALTERNATIVE ROUTES AS WILL BE DIRECTED BY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL AT THE SITE DURING THIS PERIOD.

THE AUTHORITY REGRETS ANY INCONVENIENCE THIS MAY CAUSE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.



PUBLIC NOTICE: TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE.

The Sierra Leone Roads Authority (SLRA) will install cross drains at Kossoh Town/Mokor Town Junction along the Regent - Jui Road.

Closure Period from Saturday, May 30 to Saturday, June 6, 2026.

Reopening: Sunday, June 7, 2026.

Traffic will be partially restricted, with one lane maintained for access. Motorists are advised to follow alternative routes as directed by traffic personnel.
